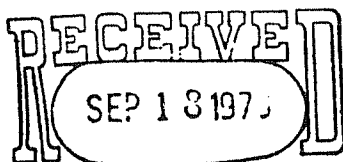
Two approved prints of the above mentioned are being returned herewith.

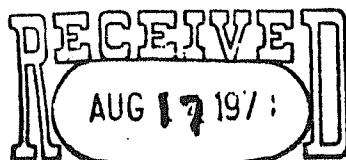
